












WEBSITE PRIVACY NOTICE - DATA COLLECTION FORM

	<p>A. DATA CATEGORIES: the object of the processing may be User's personal data such as identification data, other types of personal data and contact details.</p>
	<p>B. DATA CONTROLLER: the data controller is D-Orbit SpA, Viale Risorgimento, 57 - 22073 Fino Mornasco (CO), VAT number 07373150965, which can be contacted by telephone on 02.37920900 or by e-mail at privacy@dorbit.space.</p>
	<p>C. SOURCE OF PERSONAL DATA: personal data held by the data controller are collected directly from the User.</p>
	<p>D. PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS: the processing of personal data, collected and stored in relation to the completion of this form, has as its legal basis data subject's consent and is carried out for the following purposes: Commercial profiling activities and/or newsletter subscription and/or recruiting activities.</p>
	<p>E. DATA RECIPIENTS: within the limits pertinent to the processing purposes indicated, personal data may be communicated to data controller's partners, consulting firms, as well as private companies appointed as data processors. No personal data will be subject to dissemination.</p>
	<p>F. TRANSFER OF DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES: Personal data are not subject of transfer to a third country/this website may share some of the data collected with services located outside the European Union.</p>
	<p>G. STORAGE PERIOD: collected data will be stored no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed ("<i>principle of storage limitation</i>", art.5.1(e), GDPR) or according to the deadlines required by law. Obsolescence of the stored data in relation to the purposes for which they were collected is periodically verified.</p>
	<p>H. RIGHTS OF THE USER: the User always has the right to request the data controller to provide access to her data, to rectify or cancel them, to limit processing or not to process the data, to request data portability, to revoke the consent to processing by asserting these and other rights foreseen by GDPR by simple communication to the data controller. The User may also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.</p>
	<p>I. OBLIGATION TO COMMUNICATE DATA: provision of personal data is optional for some fields and mandatory for others (marked with an asterisk) and any failure to provide them will result in the failure to perform the requested service.</p>
	<p>J. DATA PROCESSING METHODS: personal data provided by the User will be processed in compliance with the above-mentioned regulations and the confidentiality obligations that apply to the activity of the data controller. The data may be processed with IT tools, on paper or using any other type of suitable tool in compliance with the appropriate security measures according to GDPR.</p>
	<p>L. AUTOMATED DECISIONAL PROCESSES: No automated decision-making processes are foreseen.</p>
